



Lisungwe plc - Newstrack announcement 3 December 2007

Drilling at the Chimimbe Hill Nickel prospect

Lisungwe plc, the PLUS–quoted mineral exploration company with Nickel exploration operations in Malawi, southern Africa, is pleased to announce that rotary air blast (RAB) drilling started on Monday 3 December 2007 with the object of determining the depth of Nickel mineralisation in Saprolites which pitting has demonstrated extend for at least 7 metres. This drilling campaign is anticipated to be 6 or 7 holes with an average depth of 30 metres and to take about 10 days to complete.

In the first hole currently in progress, Saprolites extend to a depth of 20 metres with Nickel values throughout.

Samples are now being dried and prepared for Niton XRF (X-ray fluorescent) analysis on site, the results of which will be reported in the immediate future.
